

ELA SMART Board Lessons

Quick Reference Guide



The CCSD ELA SMART Board Lessons are designed for teachers to use with their students to teach the 2008 SC ELA curriculum standards. Most of the ELA Lessons are based on the South Carolina Standards Support System (S3) Curriculum Project, <http://www.s2martsc.org/index.php>. The curriculum project is comprised of a **Prioritized Scope and Sequence Guide** divided into nine-week segments of time. In addition, an **Instructional Planning Guide (IGP)** which references instructional **Modules**, supporting appendixes, and documents which further detail the instructional plan is provided. All resources and documents pertaining to the SC S3 project are included in the Support Materials Folder for each grade level. These lessons are intended to provide an *additional* tool in the teacher's tool box and meant for use in conjunction with reading text books, literacy programs and other instructional tools provided by the state/district.

It is critical that teachers plan their instruction in advance for this tool to be effective.

- Teachers are **strongly urged** to preview lessons taking note of teacher pages, attachments (paperclip tab), and embedded teacher notes BEFORE teaching with a lesson.
- Lessons are organized in folders by module. Module names refer to the nine-weeks and module number. 1-1 refers to the 1st module for the first nine-weeks, **module 2-3** would be intended for the 2nd nine-weeks, 3rd set of lessons. Within each folder individual lessons are indicated by letters 1-1 A, 1-1 B, 1-1 C and so on. Please see the master list of lessons in the support materials.
- *Most* of the books included or referenced in lessons come from the **Scholastic 100 book list**, in an attempt to use materials common to every classroom.
- Please use the lesson in full screen.
- A separate SMART file will be provided to explain how to copy fonts to your computer.
- Blank slides are included so that teachers may add to/modify the lessons.
- Files on the (U:) drive are "Read Only". If you would like to make changes to the lesson you will need to save the lesson in a different location such as your (H:) drive or flash drive.
