

Setting Up Your New e5500 Laptop

Creating Local Windows Profile

- Make sure the laptop dock is plugged into a network jack
- Dock the laptop
- Startup the laptop
- Login to the network
- Local Windows Workstation Profile is Created
 - Call the help desk at 308-8181 if you cannot login or get error messages after login

Creating a Wireless Connection

- Open Connection Manager
 - Start Menu
 - All Programs
 - Dell ControlPoint
 - Connection Manager
 - Dell ControlPoint Connection Manager
- Device Status - Network Devices
 - Select Wi-Fi
 - Radio Controls
 - Airplane Mode = Off
 - Check beside Wi-Fi
- Profiles
 - Wi-Fi
 - Add
 - Ensure “Choose the type of network connections you want to configure” and “Wi-Fi Radio are checked
 - Next
 - Wi-Fi
 - Click “View” button beside Network Name
 - Highlight your network
 - OK
 - If network is secure, ensure that the proper security and encryption type are listed then type your key.
 - Use Next to set specific information for your location (You may click finish at any time. The properties of the location can be changed at any time.)
 - Finish
 - Double click “Wi-Fi” on Profiles tab
 - Click the wireless network that you just configured

Connecting to Wireless

- If wireless does not automatically connect , follow these steps
 - Start Menu
 - All Programs
 - Dell ControlPoint
 - Connection Manager
 - Dell ControlPoint Connection Manager
 - Profiles
 - Double click Wi-Fi
 - Right click appropriate wireless connection
 - Connect

You can also access the Connection Manager from the blue circle with DCP in white letters in the system tray at the lower right of your screen.
