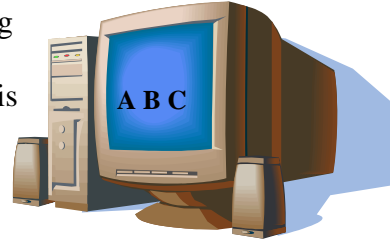


How to Use the Screen Saver Feature of Your Computer for an Educational Tool

Whether you have thematic units, or a list of weekly spelling words, you can turn your screen saver into a learning moment for your students. Let's assume you want to put this week's list of spelling words on your screen saver.



Follow these easy steps:

1. Double click on the My Computer icon on the corner of your desktop.
2. Double click on the Control Panel folder.
3. Double click on the Display icon.
4. Click on the Screen Saver tab along the top of the Display Properties dialog box.
5. Click on the arrow of the drop down box and select the "Scrolling Marquee" selection.
6. Click on the Settings button.
7. Type in the words of the week in the Text: area.
8. Click OK.
9. Click Apply.
10. Click OK.

Note: You can center and format your text for any size etc. that you want.
